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Economic Backdrop



Alberta economy resilient this year

- Solid population growth supporting consumer spending and residential construction
- Improved market access boosting oil production
- Rapid labour force **growth** outpace strong job gains



Growth to slow in 2026 before picking up over MT



- Population growth to slow amid net outflows of NPRs
- Growth in oil production and exports to moderate
- Softer outlook for oil prices
- Muted recovery in business investment




Risks to outlook high

- Trade uncertainty continues to cloud the outlook
- Tariffs a **major drag** on growth






Real GDP remains on a lower trajectory


Alberta real GDP level, Budget 2025 vs. High Scenario

Effective U.S.-imposed tariff rate against imports from Canada, by province




Monthly oil production in Alberta



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Weaker oil prices weighing on drilling activity


West Texas Intermediate (WTI) daily crude oil price

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Number of rigs drilling and five-year seasonal range




Trade headwinds hit manufacturing and agrifood exports

Value of primary agriculture & intermediate food products exports by country, 3-month moving avg.






Elevated uncertainty a drag on business sentiment

Economic Policy Uncertainty Index (Mean=100)






Year-over-year growth in the value of building permits and construction

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Seasonally adjusted non-residential building investment by type



Alberta real business investment in industries outside oil and gas extraction






Population growth to slow markedly as federal immigration targets reduce NPRs




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Job gains solid over the past year, led by services and public sector

Year-over-year change in employment by industry






Slower population growth to help with labour market rebalancing in the next few years

Labour market indicators, actuals and forecast





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


Price pressures are easing and becoming more narrow-based





Resale market firmly in balanced territory


Alberta resale market home sales and inventory

Sales-to-new listings ratio, seasonally adjusted






Consumer spending has been resilient
